SUBJECT: ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUSLIM REHABILITATION FACILITY

This letter serves to confirm Freedom Recovery Centre's (FRC) formal commitment to advising Bayt At Takreem NPC in the establishment of a rehabilitation facility dedicated to the Muslim faith.

Background and Accreditation

Established in 2008, FRC is an in-patient rehabilitation centre for individuals living with substance use disorders. We are registered with the Department of Social Development (DSD) under **the Prevention of and Treatment for Substance Abuse Act (Act 70 of 2008)** and operate in strict alignment with the national Norms and Standards.

Current Operations

FRC manages a comprehensive network of recovery services with a workforce of 155 staff and volunteers:

- In-patient Treatment & Halfway Houses: Multiple facilities across Plot 80, Plot 72, and Nigel, catering to over 180 male and female service users.
- Specialized Care: Private, medical aid, and subsidized dual-diagnosis beds.
- Community Support: Out-patient services and Skills Development Centres in Sedibeng and Ekurhuleni.
- Public Partnership: Management of the Mabutho Hlatshwayo Treatment Centre (124 beds) in partnership with the DSD.

The Vision for Faith-Based Recovery

Through our years of service, FRC has welcomed individuals of all backgrounds. However, we recognize that for recovery to be truly transformative, it must be rooted in the individual's own spiritual identity.

Having identified a significant need for a professional, clinical environment that fully integrates Islamic values and practices, FRC is committed to sharing our 15+ years of operational experience.

Our goal is to ensure that the Muslim community has access to a facility that meets the highest regulatory standards while providing a culturally and spiritually appropriate sanctuary for healing.

Scope of Advisory Commitment

FRC's role is strictly advisory and includes:

- Site & Compliance Evaluation: Assessing the suitability of the facility and documentation for DSD registration.
- Operational Guidance: Recommending processes that align with the Minimum Norms and Standards of Act 70 of 2008.
